- Licensed Clinicians whose caseload include Native families
- Licensed Tribal and Indian Health Service Behavioral Health clinicians, Tribal youth treatment program staff, Systems of Care clinical staff, urban or Youth Residential Treatment Center clinicians, or an American Indian/Alaska Native organization serving American Indian/Alaska Native children.
- Non-licensed clinician or a member of the treatment team that includes a licensed clinician trained in TFCBT serving Native families.

Honoring Children, Mending the Circle is the clinical application of the evidence-based healing process with in a traditional framework that supports the belief of American Indians and Native Alaskan culture of spiritual renewal leading to healing and recovery. Training involves a four-day intensive session, follow-up weekly case consultation, web-based training, and resources.
